South of Scotland Golden Eagle Project aims to reinforce the small, isolated and vulnerable population of Golden Eagles in the Scottish Borders and Dumfries and Galloway. The talk will introduce the Golden Eagle, an iconic symbol of wild Scotland and provide context to the project to reinforce their numbers in the South of Scotland. It will also update the audience on translocations; how the eagles are faring and our efforts to engage different communities. It has recently been reported that one of the Golden Eagles has been seen as far south as The Pennine Hills. Perhaps they will soon be seen in Cumbria!
